Peoria, AZ (October 23, 2008) – Building on their dream of homeownership the Aguer and Miburo families will celebrate an important milestone in the construction of their new home—and the community is invited to join in on the fun! The celebration begins at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 25th at 8075 and 8069 W. Cherry Hills Drive in Peoria.

The construction of this particular home is the result of three organizations—Thrivent Financial for Lutherans®, West Valley Lutheran Coalition and Habitat for Humanity Central Arizona—joining forces in an unprecedented alliance to not only build walls, but to build community as well. *Thrivent Builds with Habitat for Humanity*, an alliance between these two non-profits, was announced in September, 2005, in Minneapolis, MN, home to Thrivent Financials corporate headquarters.
